#### **BACKGROUND**

to offer different appetizing presentations for foods with modified textures intended for specific populations (elderly, dysphagic,

## **METHODS**

- dauphinois and mixed hachis Parmentier.
- Control product: unprinted hachis Parmentier with traditional presentation (90g of each mixed product).
- 8 print designs on plate : 2 shapes (round or square), 2 types of layers (homogeneous or heterogeneous) and 2 stacking of the layers (straight or pyramidal). Each plate= 6 printed hachis Parmentier of 30g (total = 180g per plate).
- Printing parameters: nozzle diameter of 3.7 mm, filling rate at 100 % and printing speed of 10 mm/s.
- Rating (between 0 and 10) by 250 consumers: 48 in sensory analysis boxes and 202 using an online survey with pictures of the plates).

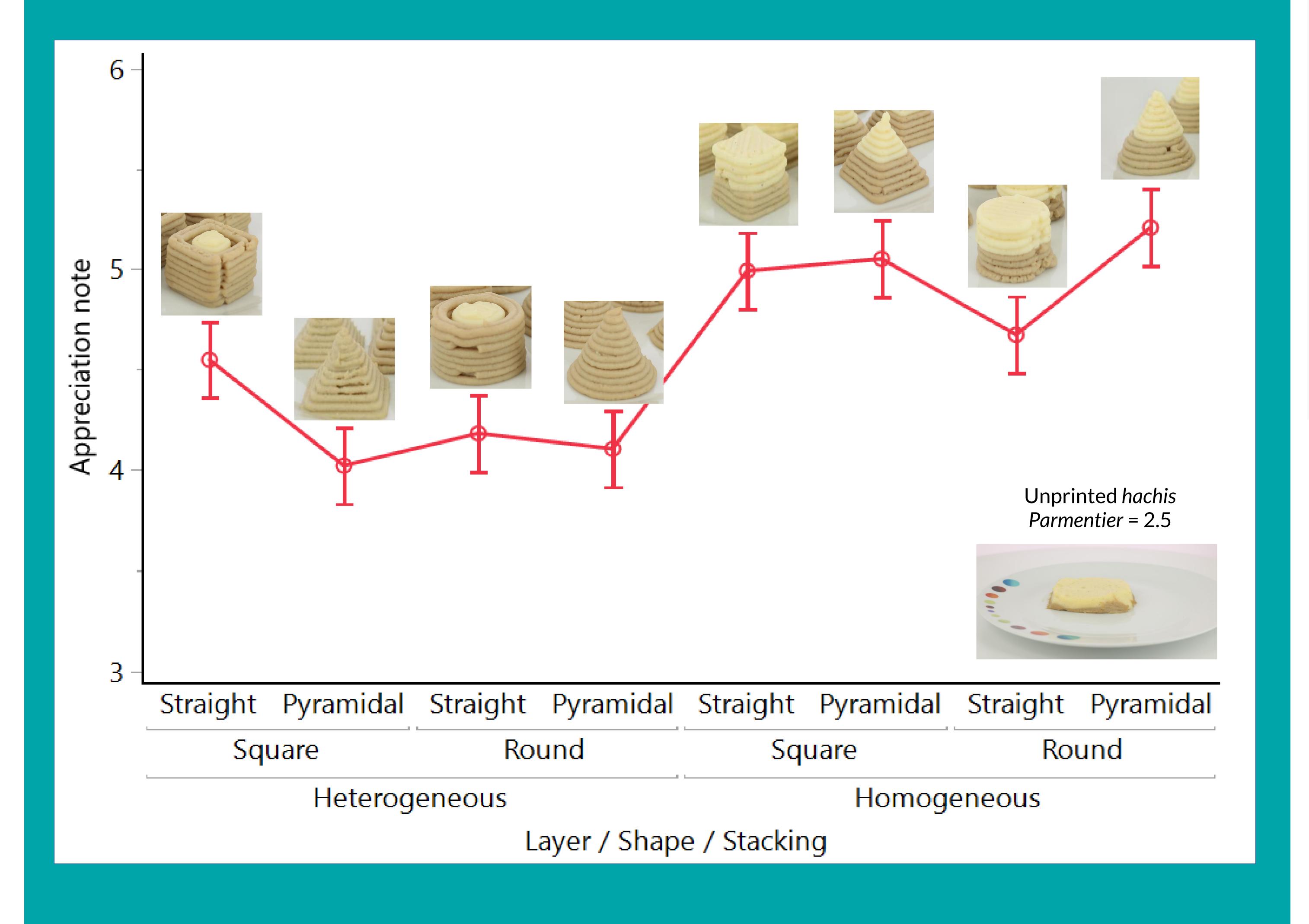
### **RESULTS**

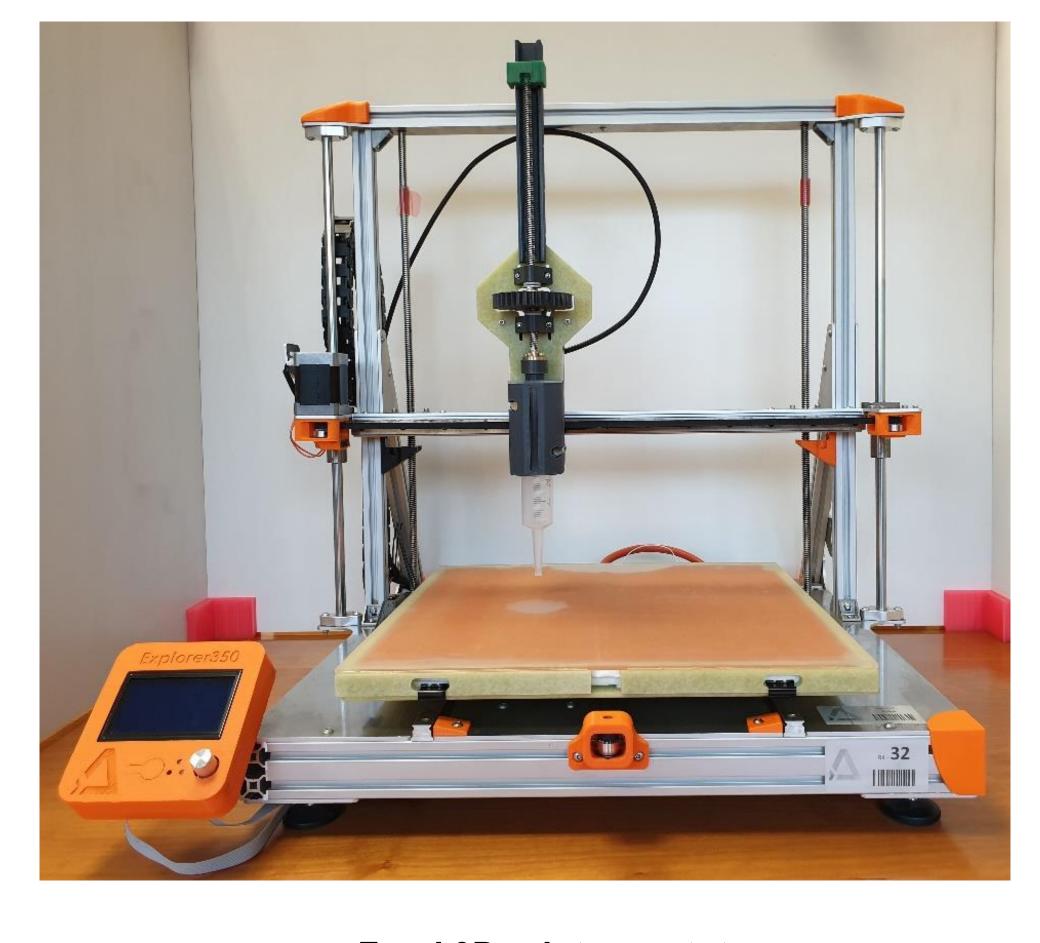
- The unprinted hachis Parmentier was the least popular.
- All the printed shapes were more appreciated than the unprinted hachis Parmentier.
- The most popular design was : round shape, homogeneous layers and pyramidal stacking.

#### **PERSPECTIVES**

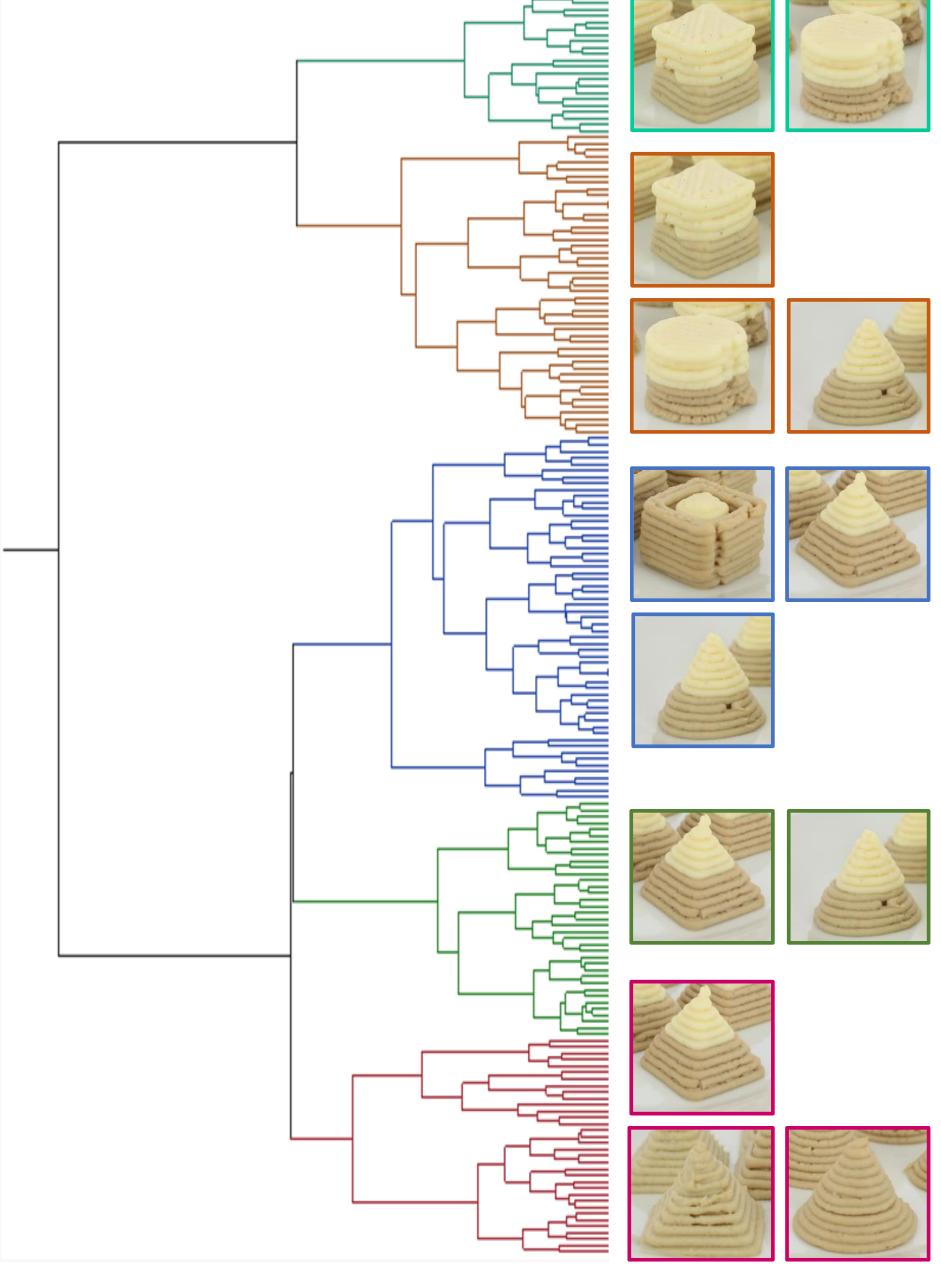
- Other designs proposed by consumers: classic big shape, sphere, polygon, star, cylinder.
- To improve : color and aspect of meat, brown the top, thin layers, less meat and more potato.
- Next step : interview specific populations (dysphagic).

3D printed hachis Parmentier is visually more appreciated than a traditional presentation. 3D designs with homogeneous layers are preferred.
